Position Description:

The DEEP Residence Life Team is responsible for the day-to-day management and execution of residence life for the DEEP Summer Academy. This program caters to high school students (aged 14-18) from around the world, who have an aptitude for math and science. The Don team provides a chance for these students to develop their leadership, organizational and interpersonal skills through living in a university residence environment. Team members have the opportunity to discover, explore and work in a unique summer program where each member is given the chance to personally contribute to and shape the program.

What Does a Senior Don Do?

Senior Dons are expected live in residence and are responsible for offering students support, leadership and guidance as members of the DEEP Residence Life Team. DEEP Dons create a sense of community while ensuring that residence rules and regulations are respected. They also organize evening and weekend programs that include athletic sessions, cultural events and sightseeing trips and more. DEEP Dons work to ensure that our students have the best experience possible.

Senior Dons will also be expected to work closely with the Residence Life Coordinator and Assistant Residence Life Coordinators in the management of day-to-day activities, acting as a primary point person for on duty staff. The Senior Don will guide and mentor other Dons. They will ensure that Dons understand schedules, activities and any other tasks, and will be expected to take the lead in crisis situations. Senior Dons are expected to assist with the development and implementation of program promotion, marketing and communication activities.
