The Engineering Outreach Office (EOO) manages and administers the core outreach programs offered by the Faculty of Applied Science & Engineering at the University of Toronto. We act as the central unit for outreach activities promoting Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) education to a wide audience. The Da Vinci Engineering Enrichment Program (DEEP) is an academically rigorous program offered by the Engineering Outreach Office (EOO) that nurtures highly motivated grade 9 to 12 students from all over the world who excel in math and science. DEEP is one of the most diverse pre-university programs in North America. DEEP courses are taught by U of T Engineering graduate students and recent alumni and take students beyond the traditional secondary school curriculum.

Volunteers will gain exposure to:

- Fostering a sense of community, engagement, inclusivity and acceptance among all DEEP participants, DEEP staff, DEEP instructors and specialists.
- Collaborating with DEEP instructors, specialists and the Engineering Outreach team, both in and out of the classroom.
- Supporting DEEP students during academic hours, after-class activities, course field trips, and excursions.
- Acting as an ambassador of the Faculty of Applied Science & Engineering and the University of Toronto.



Who should Volunteer?

Current undergraduate students in an Engineering or Science program at the University level who enjoy collaborating with and helping young adults and who have an interest in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math.

Volunteers will be provided with relevant training prior to the program start date.

As part of the requirements from the Ontario Camps Association, volunteers 18 years old or older are required to present a criminal record check to the University that is acceptable in the University's view before they commence volunteering.
